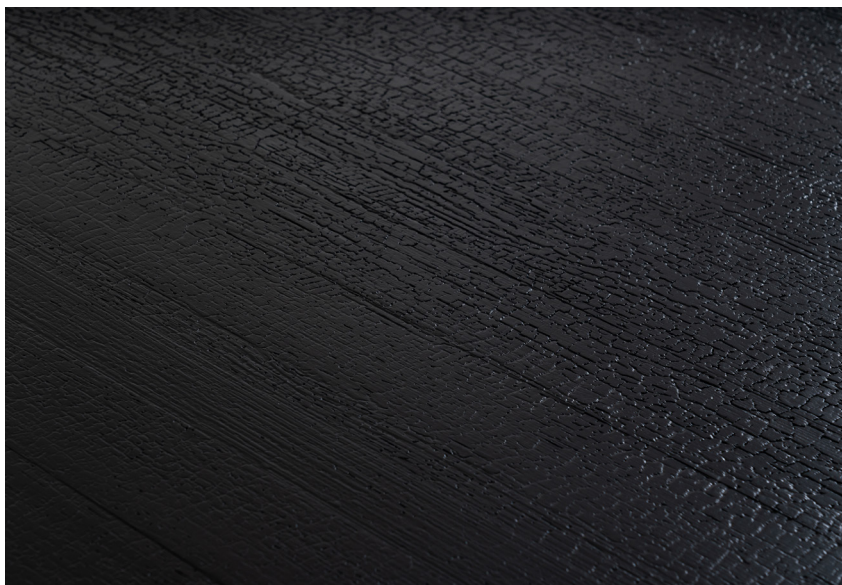
Osvaldo dining table features bronze burnished iron frame supporting a dark textured burnt-wood top.

BIO DESIGNER:

Over the years, Fabio Fantolino's studio has balanced trend design and technique, fundamental ingredients of architecture that it doses and mixes every day to achieve exclusive and exemplary results. Since 2018 he has been a juror of the Archiproducts Design Award. The philosophy that guides the design of the product for Fabio Fantolino changes according to the purpose, anticipating or postponing some common and recurring phases of the creative process. The creative approach aims to seek and interpret what is missing, realigning the rational and technical component with the more emotional and expressive one to find the right intuition in step with the design trend. Currently the Fantolino studio is working on the conservative restoration of Casa Vélo, following the artistic direction and design of the project.
