

The sculptural tables and wooden sculptures originate from the search for wood from centuries-old Italian trees that were felled due to disease or standing death. The wood is treated in a way that combines techniques that highlight the veins or natural imperfections with others that give a more contemporary texture, such as fire, sands, gilding, and resins.









BIO DESIGNER:

ROU Materiaal was founded in 2013 by Marzia De Lorenzi and Monica Cortesi, driven by their desire to explore the world of "handmade" and unleash their previously unexpressed creativity, experimenting with various materials for custom projects. The surfaces become a field of research. The focus of the research and experimentation is on large linen canvases and solid wood boards. Resins and acrylics are the main medium, later supplemented by plaster and cement. The worked surfaces of ROU Materiaal evoke stones. The connection between a "primitive" material world and the search for contemporary shapes and textures represents the guiding thread of ROU Materiaal's philosophy.
